## Commissioner Candidate Completes 230-Mile Run in Hamilton County's 52 Residential ZIP-Codes.

**Herman for Hamilton** 

CINCINNATI – Dr. Herman Najoli, an Independent Candidate for Commissioner, has completed 230 miles of jogging in his bid to become the next Hamilton County Commissioner. Starting on May 14th and running in every ZIP Code in Hamilton County, Dr. Najoli completed this unprecedented goal on July 12th. His purpose for running 230 miles was to highlight that he is the first Independent Candidate and first Black male to make the General Election ballot for Commissioner in Hamilton County's 230-year history.

Established in 1790, the County named after Caribbean immigrant Alexander Hamilton, is marking 230 years of existence in 2020. In the 230-years, no Independent and no Black male has made it to the County Commissioner ballot. Dr. Najoli jogged an average of 4.4 miles and 17,446 steps in each ZIP Code. In total, he completed 907,210 steps in all 52 ZIP Codes that he jogged in. All the runs were tracked through MapMyRun and updated with daily videos that were posted on Facebook and Youtube.

This is the only run of its kind in the history of Hamilton County. Dr. Najoli is the first candidate for public office in Hamilton County to launch his campaign with physical running in every ZIP Code. Having completed the runs, Dr. Najoli and his team are planning to premiere a full-feature length campaign film, TWO HUNDRED THIRTY MILES. According to campaign scheduling, the movie will be released on July 18.
