CINCINNATI – The County Commissioner campaign of educator and public servant, Dr. Herman Najoli, is bringing back a wonderful tradition with a Whistle Stop Tour through Hamilton County. This week Dr. Najoli is set to visit the sites of the storied Norwood depot at Forest and Harris, the renowned Greendale depot on Greenville Avenue, the Madeira depot on Railroad Avenue, and the Silverton depot on Montgomery Road. The Whistle Stop tour begins on Monday and ends on Friday.

In keeping with current COVID-19 risk level guidelines for Hamilton County, there are no invitations for the Whistle Stop Tour. All appearances will be video-taped and posted on the same day on the campaign's Facebook and YouTube pages. As always, Dr. Najoli will interact with voters online and answer any questions that come up regarding his comments within a 24-hour period.
